Fundraiser & Silent Auction For The Wong's

On December 12, 2009, our dear friend Jason and his father, Wah Wong, were struck by a drunk driver while unloading luggage from their driveway. The car crashed into Wah and Jason, severely injuring the father and crushing the legs of his son. Jason's right leg was severely broken and his left leg had to be amputated below the knee.

The driver, 50-year-old Rodney Dean James, had a blood-alcohol content of 0.19, which is twice the legal limit in the state of Washington.

Jason and his father are now dependent for the care of their family who must tend to all their daily needs. In addition to the grueling physical recovery, the family now has the burden of the accumulating pile of medical expenses including: bills

for surgery, hospital visits and daily medication, and an estimated \$20,000 to \$50,000 for a prosthetic leg.

Another devastating blow that has impacted the Wong family is the temporary closure to their restaurant, *Jade West Cafe*, in West Seattle. The inability to keep their business running has put them in a financial bind. A void has also been created as the patrons of *Jade West Cafe*, and the community of West Seattle, are near and dear in the hearts of the Wong family.

Despite this accident, Jason still has a positive and optimistic outlook on life and a bright future ahead of him. With your support we hope to continue to help him and his family through this trying time in their lives.
